

**Materials:** Color notes and yardage requirements are based on the feature quilt. While you can replace with your own, just keep in mind that your changes might also change the yardage requirements, as would any fussy cutting you may require. Each fabric is noted by map position.

**Templates:** All templates are provided, but using my Moonbeam Acrylic & Mylar sets are a help!

**Solids:** In the Log Cabin blocks there are three different solid categories (red, green, blue) and they each progress from light to dark in 3 shades, for a total of 9 solid fabrics.

- (C & F) Light Green Solid: 1/3 yard
- (C & F) Medium Green Solid: 1/2 yard
- (C & F) Dark Green Solid: 5/8 yard
- (G) Light Red Solid: 1/4 yard
- (G) Medium Red Solid: 3/8 yard
- (G) Dark Red Solid: 1/2 yard
- (C) Light Blue Solid: 1/4 yard
- (C) Medium Blue Solid: 3/8 yard
- (C) Dark Blue Solid: 1/2 yard

**Small Prints:** Similar to the progression of three fabrics in each solid category, the log cabin blocks also have light/medium/dark progressions of smaller scale prints in two color categories (warm tones and cool tones). There is also enough included to allow for the applique to be cut from scraps.

- (G) Light Warm Print: 1/4 yard
- (G) Medium Warm print: 3/4 yard
- (G) Dark Warm Print: 3/4 yard
- (F) Light Cool Print: 1/4 yard
- (F) Medium Cool Print: 3/8 yard
- (F) Dark Cool Print: 3/4 yard
- (F/C Applique) Pale Floral: 1/2 yard

**Feature Prints:** These are larger in scale and occupy the whole blocks, log cabin centers as well as the border elements. They all have somewhat symmetrical design features and are noted by position. Depending on your repeat size, you may need more or less than listed.

- (A , C, G ) Center Block (and warm log cabin centers): 1 yard
- (B) Top & Bottom Blocks: 3/4 yard
- (D) Right & Left Blocks: 3/4 Yard
- (E) Four Whole Corners: 2 1/2 yards
- (H) Four 1/2 Corners: 1 1/4 yard
- (I & J) Borders: 2 1/2 yards (horizontal stripes) or 1 3/4 yards (vertical stripes)
- (F) Cool Log Cabin Centers: 1/3 yard

**Backing:** 3 yards of 108" wide or 6 yards of 44" wide

**Batting:** 96 x 96"

**Binding:** 1 1/4 yards (you'll need 11 yards, this yardage will allow cutting 2.25" wide on WOF)
