

## Teddy Bear Pattern

Please use 100% Cotton or Flannel

Cut 2 - 10-1/2" x 11-1/2" of one fabric

Cut 1 - 10-1/2" x 11-1/2" freezer paper for template

Print out teddy bear template provided and cut along lines.

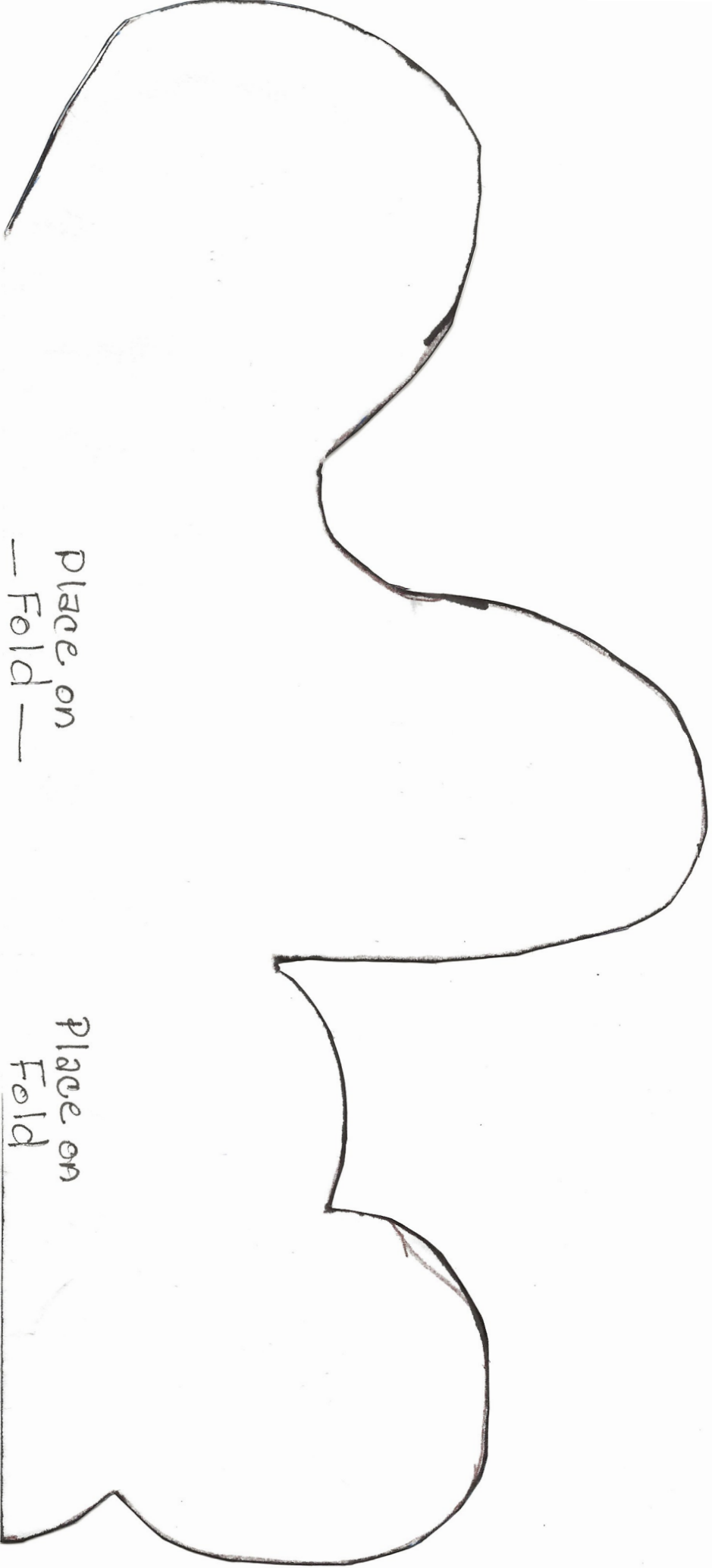
Fold the freezer paper in half lengthwise. Place template with long straight edge on fold of freezer paper. Cut around edges to make full size teddy bear template.

Layer the two pieces of fabric wrong sides together. Pin the teddy bear template to your layered fabric and cut along edges. Remove template and pin fabric wrong sides together. Stitch along edges with  $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam allowance leaving an opening for stuffing your bear.

The edges need to be pinked. You can do that before stuffing but need to be careful to leave your seam allowance at the opening. Or you can pink the edges after stuffing your bear. Stitch the opening by machine or by hand. When pinking the edges, be careful not to cut into your stitching!

Tie a ribbon around the bear's neck and you are done!

If you don't have ribbon we can add that before handing off the bear to Northside.
